Slip Bobbering Walleye

If your target is a lake point, a submerged reef or shoal, anchor your boat upwind of the structure. Let your bobber float back over the target. Make sure your bait is about 1' off bottom. Use a thin long bodied float in calm water and a fatlar body in rougher water.

Smallmouth Bass Fishing Tip

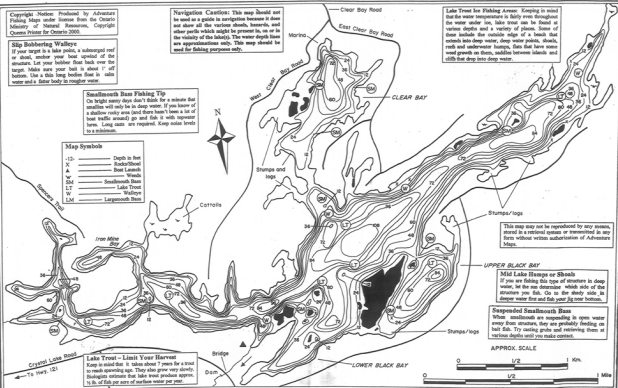
On bright sunny days don't think for a minute that smallies will only be in deep water. If you know of a shallow rocky area (and there hasn't been a lot of boat traffic around) go and fish it with topwater lures. Long casts are required. Keep noise levels to a minimum.

Lake Trout Ice Fishing Areas: Keeping in mind that the water temperature is fairly even throughout the water under ice, lake trout can be found at various depths and a variety of places. Some of these include the outside edge of a beach that extends into deep water, deep water points, shoals, reefs and underwater bumps, flats that have some weed growth on them, saddles between islands and cliffs that drop into deep water.



Lake Trout - Limit Your Harvest

Keep in mind that it takes about 7 years for a trout to reach spawning age. They also grow very slowly. Biologists estimate that lake trout produce approx. 1/4 lb. of fish per acre of surface water per year.

UPPER BLACK BAY

Mid Lake Humps or Shoals

If you are fishing this type of structure in deep water, let the net determine which side of the structure you fish. Go to the steady side, in deeper water first and fish your jig near bottom.

Suspended Smallmouth Bass

When smallmouth are suspending in open water away from structure, they are probably feeding on bait fish. Try casting grub and retrieving them at various depths until you make contact.
