## What is Household Hazardous Waste?

HHW products are often marked with the above standardized warning symbols. Common HHW products include:

- ✓ acids
- ✓ aerosols
- ✓ antifreeze
- ✓ automotive lubricants & filters
- ✓ batteries (all types)
- ✓ cleaners, detergents & polishes
- ✓ fertilizers
- ✓ fuels (all types)
- ✓ herbicides & pesticides
- ✓ paints, stains & thinners
- ✓ pharmaceuticals
- ✓ pool chemicals
- ✓ propane canisters (all sizes)
- ✓ sealants & adhesives
- ✓ toxic pet care products

## Limited Quantities

Each household or small business may bring up to 25 gallons (120L) during each calendar year. The depots cannot accept materials in containers larger than 5 gallons (20L).

## How do I safely transport HHW?

- ✓ leave materials in original containers
- ✓ never mix substances
- ✓ securely pack material in your vehicle to prevent spills

## The New Sticker Program

The "Don't Dump Me" program is designed to let people know which types of products are household hazardous waste. When you see this sticker, it means that the product you just purchased and other similar products are HHW. Any leftovers from HHW products need to be disposed of at an HHW facility. Dumping in ditches, storm drains and fields pollutes our environment and is illegal. Thanks to all of the participating hardware stores!

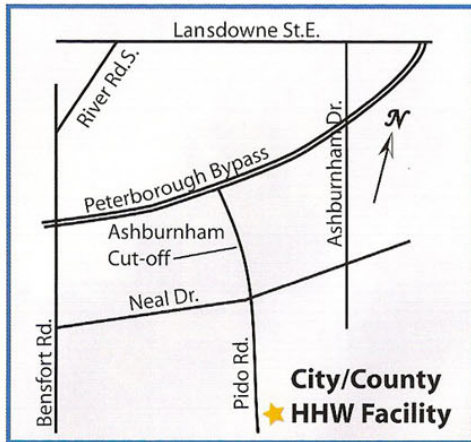
## Paint & Stain Exchange

## Additional Materials

The following additional materials are accepted only at this facility. See reverse side for additional accepted materials.

- ✓ computer monitors (\$5 ea)
- ✓ computers (2 free components/yr, then \$5 ea)
- ✓ electronics
- ✓ fluorescent light bulbs/tubes (12 free/yr, then \$1ea)
- ✓ mercury thermometers/thermostats
- ✓ sharps (enclosed in a puncture proof container)



# Seasonal County HHW Depots

The County of Peterborough offers residents the convenience of five seasonal HHW facilities, operating from May to October. Residents need to be ready to show their current dump card. County residents may also use the HHW facility in the City of Peterborough.
