

# **Crystal Lake Cottager's Association - Executive Meeting - March 18, 2008**

## **Meeting Minutes**

Attendees: Nevil Knupp - President, Evelyn Windsor - Treasurer, Sharon Brickman – Executive,

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. via teleconference.

Evelyn confirmed that invoices for \$275.00 to Shaklee and Peter Franzen for 2008 advertising. It was also confirmed by Nevil Crowe Dock will not renew their advertising for 2008 so their ad will be deleted from the website – Nevil to action. Evelyn confirmed invoices were sent to Dianne Stender, Walsten Marine and it was agreed Nevil should follow up with Julie Austin regarding their renewal.
